

Serving on the State Officer Nominating Committee

The State Officer Candidate Nominating Committee is truly one of the most important and influential standing committees of the Wyoming FFA Association. Three students will be selected to work with the adult committee members to evaluate and consider the candidates running for state office. After considering the candidates the committee develops and recommends their committee report, which outlines the slate of officers.

Nominating Committee members will give up a great deal of their convention experience to participate in the selection process. The job also requires long hours and some mature, and often emotionally charged, discussions about potential candidates. The reward though, is getting to participate first hand in the selection process, and helping determine the leaders of your association for the coming year.

State Officer Nominating Committee members should possess the following characteristics:

- Honesty
- Confidentiality
- Trustworthiness
- Maturity
- Unwavering Morals and Values
- Passion for the Wyoming FFA Association

To be selected for the state officer nominating committee, you must:

1. Be an affiliated FFA member with a chapter in good standing with the state association.
2. Be a senior in high school.
3. Hold the State FFA Degree at the time of the 2016 state convention.
4. Be available to participate in all nominating committee meetings and discussions, as outlined in the 2016 Wyoming State FFA Convention Schedule.
5. Agree to take the committee seriously, participate honestly and keep all matters of the committee confidential, both during and after the 2016 Wyoming State FFA Convention.
