

Wyoming FFA Chapter AGvocacy Week Participation Ideas

1. Make a public presentation. This could include a prepared speaking exhibition or perhaps a group presentation about agriculture as a whole, agricultural issues or current events in agriculture.
2. Host an Ag expo for younger members of the community. Consider displays of animals or plants with simple explanations of where these products can be used.
3. Write commercials or create advertisements. Forge partnerships with local radio stations or television news channels. Include a section in your local newspaper, which includes articles explaining the relevance of agriculture.
4. Host a bake sale for your community. One idea is to display the ingredients and a timeline of the ingredients life from seed to table.
5. Host an open house or ranch/ farm tour. This tour might include a "Day in the Life of a Farmer" where students are given a normal task like building fence or stacking bales, which is a good tactile representation of how hard farmers/ ranchers work to put food on the table.
6. Share agriculture trivia questions during the day. Partner with local radio stations, newspapers, or work through your school to give community/ school members a chance to test their agricultural knowledge. You can offer a prize to increase participation.
7. Visit a local grocery store and talk to customers about the industry.
