

Wyoming AGvocacy Week Video Competition

Participate in our <u>Wyoming AGvocacy Week Video competition for FFA Chapters</u> and tell the agriculture story!

- Produce a video and/or commercial, with your fellow chapter FFA members, on the topic of "Ag is the Answer." Videos should be no more than 60 seconds in length and capture the spirt of being an advocate for agriculture. How you address the topic is entirely up to you. You can choose to act out a scene, use graphics, and discuss why it's important to have advocates or how a strong voice for agriculture will affect our world's future. Be creative!
- **Submit** your video to State FFA Advisor Stacy Broda at **sbroda@yahoo.com**. Please include your chapter's name and phone number, as well the names of all the students who helped create the video. Videos should be in Quicktime format, Video Codec H.264, file type .mov, frame rate at least 23, and size at least 1280x1080. Feel free to upload the video to YouTube or another file sharing and simply share the link with Mrs. Broda.
- **Win** The winning video will be chosen by the 2015-2016 State FFA Officers. The chapter with the top video will receive a **\$100 prize**, donated by the Wyoming FFA Association. The winning chapter will also receive a private celebration with the state officers to be held sometime during the 2016 State FFA Convention. We will work out the details with your advisor!
- **Exceptional** videos will be played during the 2016 State FFA Convention. They'll also be posted on the Wyoming FFA Facebook page, web page and YouTube channel.
- **Entries** must be the original work of current Wyoming FFA members. Chapters may submit more than one video for consideration, provided each video is the work of different students. For example, your chapter could submit a video created by the senior class, and another video created by the freshman class. Be sure to give each video a unique name and provide the relevant information.
- **Deadline** for entries is **February 3, 2016, at 5 p.m. MST**. Entries must be submitted in their entirety by the deadline.
- Winners will be announced during National FFA Week in February 2016.
